There will be a “Ladies Who Lunch” on Fridays in June at Wautoma Center.

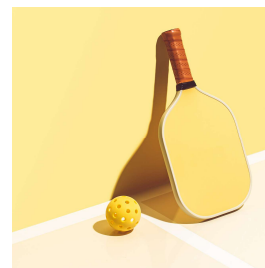
ENJOY PICKLEBALL AT THE CENTER

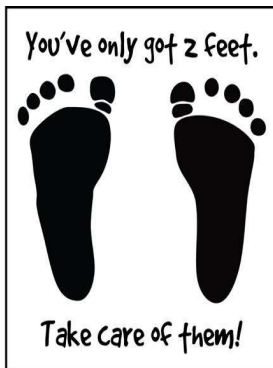
