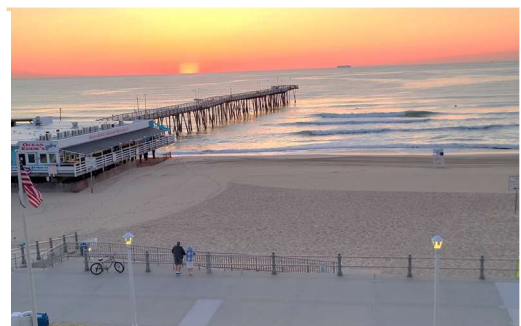
Day Trips - Sign-up for Lunch Creek and Timber Rattlers

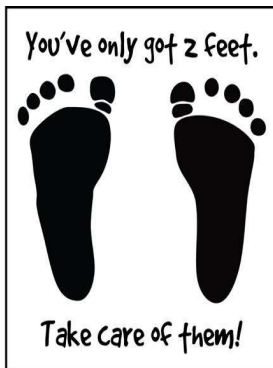
